

Current Transducer LTSR 15-NP

For the electronic measurement of currents: DC, AC, pulsed, mixed, with galvanic isolation between the primary circuit (high power) and the secondary circuit (electronic circuit).

Notes: $^{1)}$ Only in ref_out mode or with external REF less than 2.525 V and greater than 2.475 V. For external REF out of these limits see leaflet. $^{2)}$ \textbf{V}_{out} is linked to \textbf{V}_{REF} , by conception the difference between these two nodes for $\textbf{I}_{\textbf{P}}=0$ is maximum \pm 25 mV, 2.475 V < \textbf{V}_{out} < 2.525 V. $^{3)}$ In Ref_out mode at $\textbf{T}_{\textbf{A}}=25^{\circ}\text{C}$, 2.475 V < \textbf{V}_{REF} < 2.525 V. The minimal impedance loading the ref pin should be > 220 k Ω . Internal impedance = 600 Ω . Ignoring this warning can lead to injury and/or cause serious damage.


This transducer is a built-in device, whose conducting parts must be inaccessible after installation.

Remarks

- V_{OUT} swings above the 2.5 V offset when I_p flows from terminals 1, 2, 3 to terminals 4, 5, 6 (with the arrow)
- For the EMC, the acceptance criteria are available on request
- Temperature of the primary conductor should not exceed 100°C.
